SENCITY®LINK at VW do Brazil

The success story of HUBER+SUHNER's point-to-point link SL60 is never ending. The wireless Ethernet bridge, which, with a transmission rate of 100 Mbps, is fully duplex and provides a wireless bridge over a distance of up to 800 metres, has also impressed the planners at VW in Rio de Janeiro.

For Luiz Gustavo de Oliveira, IT coordinator at VW Truck & Bus in Brazil, the SENCITY®LINK offers the ideal solution to his transmission problem. Bottlenecks in capacity necessitate a new logistics system and increased production in the Rio workshops as quickly as possible. The originally conceived construction of a fibreglass line for connecting data and telephone circuits has taken too long in view of the urgent need to expand capacity. Then, just at the right time, the possibility arose of using two wireless links to install the newly required data circuits. Furthermore, the link can be installed in a matter of a few hours, including configuration. HUBER+SUHNER's wireless ethernet bridge has been running smoothly since January 2008 to the total satisfaction of the Brazilian customer.
